City crews have flushed the system impacted by the Swanzy Reservoir issue. In the impacted area, residents are now advised to run cold water for 5 to 10 minutes.

- If sediment or dirt is present, run until clear.
- If sediment or dirt is present for more than 5 minutes, contact the Water Department after-hours customer line at (707) 648-4313.

The City appreciates the patience of those residents impacted and the quick response by City crews to locate, isolate and address the issue.



Previously released Information:

- Approximately 1000 households impacted by sediment being sucked into the system from the bottom of Swanzy Reservoir.
- Lemon Street to Highway 780 to Laurel Street and South to Pueblo Way, west to Porter Street and north back to Lemon Street.
