## Cycle 5 Process Update


As a part of the City of Vallejo's annual budget approval process, the Cycle 5 **vote results** were presented to City Council during a Study Session on May 30. As next steps, the results will be presented for consideration as a part of the Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget, and it is anticipated that projects totaling \$1 million will be funded when the budget is adopted. City Staff will work with implementing partners to develop contracts to bring projects to fruition in Fall 2018.

## Submit Ideas for Cycle 6, Now!

The City invites Vallejo residents, organizations and stakeholders to **submit ideas** for the sixth cycle of **PB**, from now until Sunday, October 7.

During the Idea Collection Phase, the City will accept capital infrastructure and program and service ideas at public events, upcoming budget assemblies, and in the City Manager's Office, located at 555 Santa Clara Street. Community members can also submit ideas on **AppCivist**, an online collaboration platform developed by **Social Apps Lab at CITRIS**.
