## City Funds Cycle 6 Projects

Between April 1 and May 22, more than 4,000 Vallejoans cast a PB ballot.

On June 11, during the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget, City Council allocated \$1 million to Cycle 6 projects. This allocation funds nine out of the twelve projects.

| Upgrading Handheld Radios for Vallejo Police Department      | \$270,000         | 494   |
| Firefighter Youth Academy                                    | \$65,350          | 456   |
| Improvements & Repairs to Florence Douglas Center (FDC)      | \$85,904          | 392   |

\*Partial funding recommended to budget for \$1 million cap

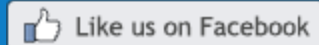

Project funding is provided to implementing partners on a reimbursement basis, and disbursed after progress reports and request for payment forms are submitted.
