VALLEJO, CA – Vallejo Police Chief Andrew Bidou and the Department are pleased to announce the 2015 launch of the Police Advisory Group. This diverse committee will represent all corners of Vallejo. Members will include citizens, business owners, the faith based community, the youth of Vallejo, and representatives of our schools.

In recognition of the importance of partnerships and collaboration with everyone who contributes to a safer and more productive Vallejo, Chief Bidou looks for those within the community who want to offer their perspectives and their solutions.

“The focus of the Police Advisory Group will be to address community concerns that center around public safety with a shared commitment toward building positive relationships that will drive this advisory group toward success”, said Chief Bidou.

A driving goal of the program is to create an environment where our community feels that their Police Department is accessible and values the input of the community regarding public safety and quality of life matters.

The role of Advisory Group members, selected by Chief Bidou, includes but is not limited to the following:

- Act as a sounding board to the Police Chief regarding community needs and concerns, and provide feedback to proposed police programs and priorities
- Share with the Police Chief the community’s need for police services and feedback on the delivery of services
- Assist in educating the community about the function and role of the Police Department
- Attend meetings at the police station with the Police Chief or his designee
