CITY OF VALLEJO PROVIDES COVID-19 UPDATE #2

VALLEJO, CA – The City of Vallejo and [Solano County Public Health](#) continue to monitor local conditions and circumstances associated with COVID-19. So as to respond to the rapidly evolving event, the Vallejo City Council will hold a Special City Council Meeting on Monday, March 16 at 6:00 p.m. to consider declaration of a local emergency which would allow for greater flexibility in the deployment of City employees, acquisition of needed equipment, supplies and other resources to ensure continuity of City operations, and other State and Federal resources for the community.

The City continues to hold ongoing, internal briefings to assess the event, deploy plans, and advance phased response strategies. The City is prepared to activate the emergency operation center as the event necessitates.

The City is partnering with other local agencies including the Vallejo City Unified School District in order to plan for future community needs.

As the lead local agency, Solano Public Health is continuing to work with state and federal partners to keep local governments informed and up-to-date on this rapidly evolving pandemic.
