C dock end tie; D dock; E dock (Guest Dock); I dock (including I outer perimeter).

J043-J045 (including JOP2); J088-J091 (including JOP3); J130-J137 (including JOP4).

K030-K032 (including KOP5); K077-K079 (including KOP6); K115-K138 (including KOP7).

The hours of dredge operations will be: 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday.
