If you are not able to connect due to the distance between your vessel and the WiFi antennas, you may need to purchase a WiFi "booster".

We cannot guarantee that you will be able to connect, but most, if not all of our berthers that have purchased boosters are able

## Security Cameras Installed

The Marina has installed the first of many security cameras. These are monitored 24 hours a day by the Vallejo Police Department. Marina staff will also be able to view and review digital recordings of any incidents that occur within the Marina parking lots. We currently have the ability to view two lots at this time, and will be installing cameras for the remaining lots in the coming months. The cameras have incredible clarity and can zoom in to capture faces and license plate numbers.

Please remember to NOT leave valuables in your vehicles as this will most certainly tempt any would be criminals to smash and grab your belongings.

## NO BLACKWATER DISCHARGE

Any fuel, oil, or hazardous material discharged (tossed, swept, funneled etc.) overboard can result in fines and clean up costs. ## VESSEL TURN IN PROGRAM

Effective January 1st 2016, the Vallejo Municipal Marina qualified to receive funding to aid the public in disposing of unwanted vessels.

The Vessel Turn In Program (VTIP) provides an alternative for boat owners to surrender unwanted recreational vessels to participating agencies.

The verified titleholder must be free of any loan balances, liens and/or taxes. Proof of ownership is required, and a release of interest must be completed and provided to the Marina office.
