Dredging Update

Over the past few months Lind Marine has been working tirelessly on dredging specific areas of the Vallejo Marina. The dredged areas include the north entrance to the wooden docks and fairways going down to the fuel dock. These areas have between nine to fourteen ft. of water at any given time. J dock slips 89 to 70, 90-108, and the J-Dock fairway was also dredged. The individual slips were dredged to 7 ft., and the fairway to 8ft.

Thinking About Selling Your Boat?

A few important reminders regarding boat sales and Slip Rental Agreements:

- Slip Rental Agreements are non-transferable. When selling your boat, make sure the new owner has made arrangements for the boat to be removed from the marina or has completed the application process and executed a Slip Rental Agreement prior to the sale being final.
- Upon termination of a Slip Rental Agreement, unless a new agreement with the new owner has been executed, sold boats must be removed immediately.
- We ask and encourage you to write a courtesy letter or email to the marina office notifying us of your intent to sell your boat.
