

RESOLUTION NO. 12-116 N.C.

RENAMING "THE DEPARTMENT HEAD AND EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT" SECTION OF THE CITY'S SALARY SCHEDULE TO "UNREPRESENTED EMPLOYEES," AND AMENDING THIS SECTION TO ADD THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY CLASSIFICATIONS AND PAY RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-12

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vallejo as follows:

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-007 N.C. approving the employment agreement setting forth the terms and conditions of employment with the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2001, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 01-191 N.C. approving the employment agreement setting forth the terms and conditions of employment of Frederick G. Soley to serve as the City Attorney, which has been amended from time to time thereafter by Council resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the CalPERS Board of Administration adopted Section 570.6 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations on April 13, 2011 and it became effective as of August 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this regulation requires the pay rate and special compensation of employees that are members of the California Public Employees Retirement System (CalPERS) to be in a single document that has been approved by the governing body and is available for public view; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to rename "the Department Head and Executive Assistant" section of the City's Salary Schedule to "Unrepresented Employees" and amend this section to add the City Manager and City Attorney classifications and pay rates for Fiscal Year 2011-12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vallejo that "the Department Head and Executive Assistant" section of the City's Salary Schedule is renamed "Unrepresented Employees" and that this section is amended to include the City Manager and City Attorney classifications and their pay rates as set forth in **Exhibit 1** to this Resolution, which is incorporated herein by this reference, and that said classifications and pay rates are hereby ratified and adopted by the City Council and incorporated into the City of Vallejo Salary Schedule effective July 1, 2011.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to take and/or authorize such other administrative action(s) necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
