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City Of Vallejo, in Partnership with GVRD Will Open Warming Shelter

Wed. January 4 and Thurs. January 5 - 8:00 pm to 7:00 am

VALLEJO, CA – In anticipation of the incoming rainstorm, the City of Vallejo, in partnership with the Greater Vallejo Recreation District (GVRD), will open an overnight warming shelter for those seeking respite from the cold and rain Wednesday, January 4, and Thursday, January 5. The shelter will open in the evenings from 8:00 pm to 7:00 am the following morning.

The shelter will be located at the Norman C. King Community Center, 545 Magazine St, Vallejo, CA 94590.

Thanks to the generosity of our partners at <u>SolTrans</u>, those seeking transportation to and from the warming shelter will be provided with a free bus ride by simply mentioning to the driver that they are "traveling to or from the Vallejo warming shelter."

Additionally, participants are encouraged to bring their own blankets and will be limited to bringing in one small bag of personal items as space is limited.
