Insurance Requirements* Checklist and Applicant Signature Needed

☐ Commercial General Liability	\$2,000,000 per occurrence (more than 500 persons per day*) \$1,000,000 per occurrence (up to 500+ persons per day) \$2M or 4M Aggregate (depending on projected attendance)
☐ Business Automobile Liability	\$1,000,000 per occurrence, including owned, non-owned and hired vehicles
☐ Workers Compensation (Statutory)	\$1,000,000

☐ Additional Insured Endorsement (General & Auto)	The City must be named an additional insured on the standard industry form (known as an ACORD 25 form) and on an endorsement form using the following language:
	"The City of Vallejo, its officers, agents and employees are included as additional insured on all policies except Workers' Compensation."
	Endorsement must state that coverage is primary insurance. Insurance must cover on an occurrence basis, not on a claims-made basis.
